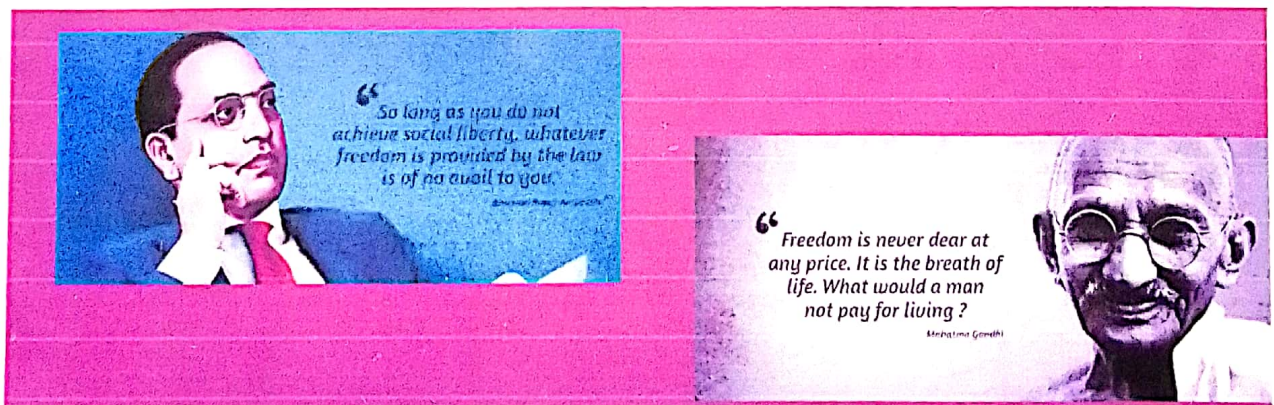
76th Independence Day on 15th August 2022

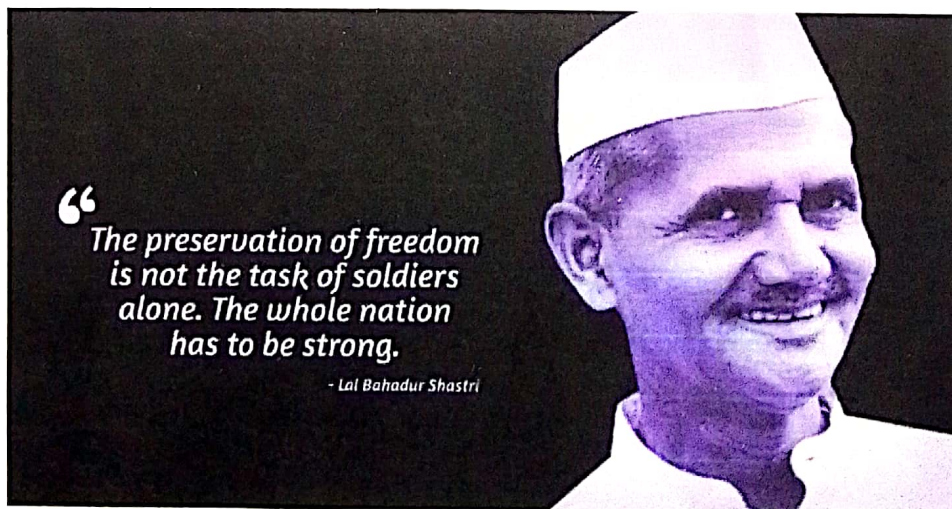

Summary of Program Schedules

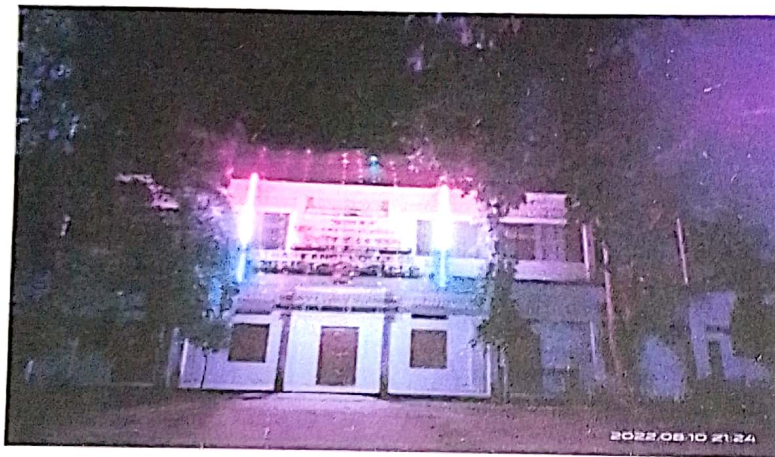
1. Lightening the College campus from 11/08/2022 to 15th August, 2022.
2. Chief Minister's Institutional Plantation Programme (CMIPP) from 18th July, 2022 to 15th August, 2022. Patharkandi College will continue the programme of plantation from 01/08/2022 to 15/08/2022. Two hundred (200) sapling have been planted at the college premises.
3. Bike Rally for awareness on Har Ghar Tiranga programme in the eve of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav on 08/08/2022 at 10:30 am from Patharkandi College to Asimganj.

10. Singing & quiz competition among the students held on 13/08/2022 & 14/08/2022 in the College premises.
11. Partition Horror exhibition on 14th August at College Premises.
12. Cultural night programme was organised on 13/08/2022 & 14/08/2022 from 6:30 onwards.
13. 76th Independence Day Flag Hoisting ceremony held on 15th August at 8:00 am with Rastriya Gan (Jana gana Mana) and Principal's lecture & Certificate distribution to the students especially four teachers.

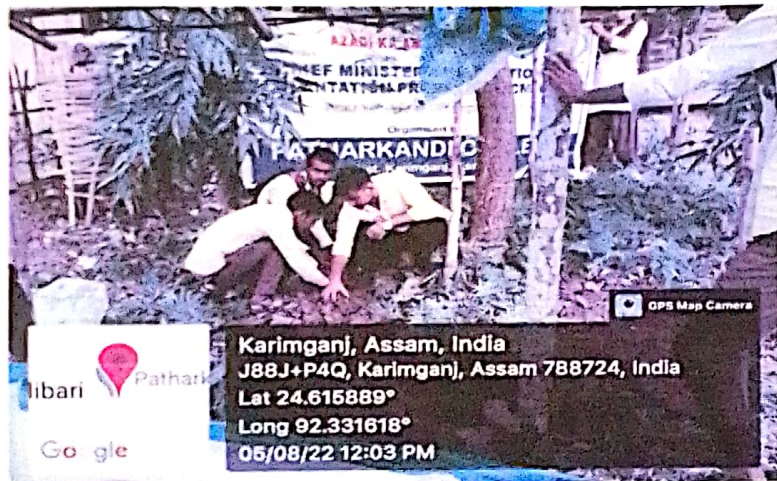
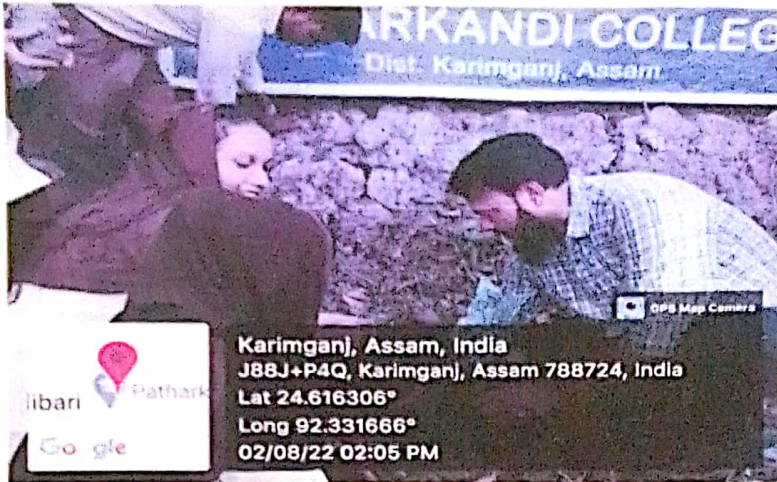
01 August to 15 August, 2022

Plantation at College campus

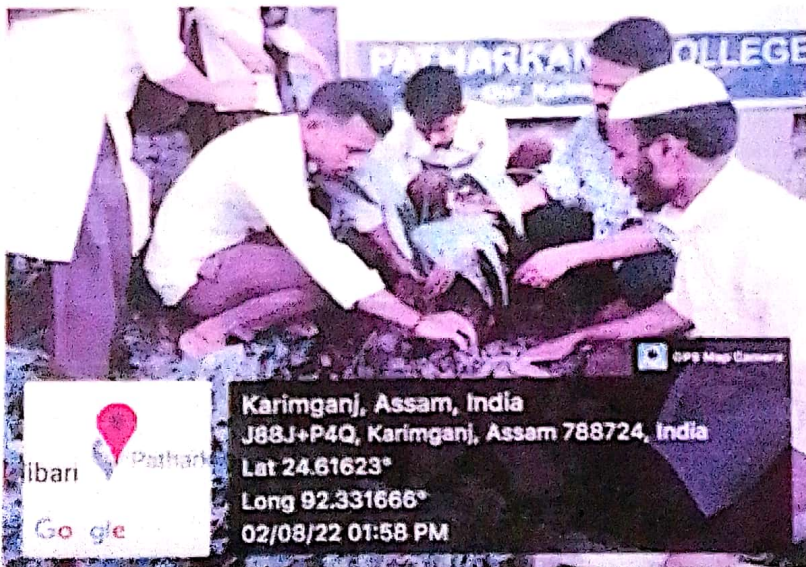
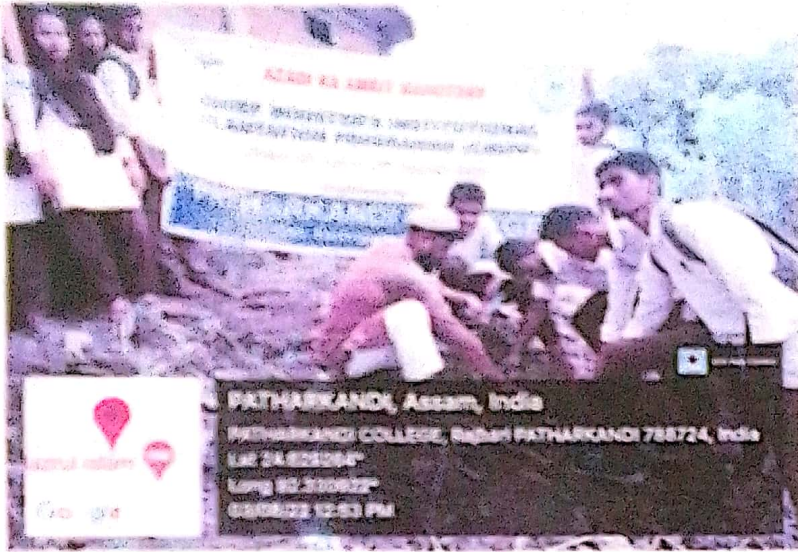

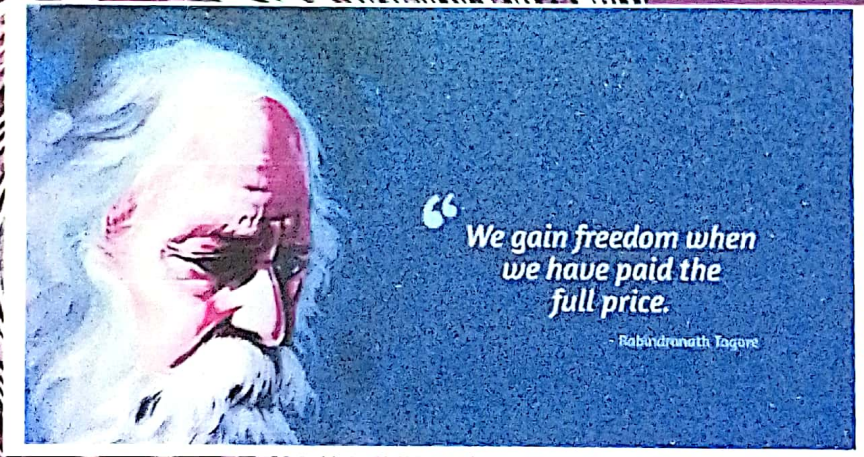

Rally from College

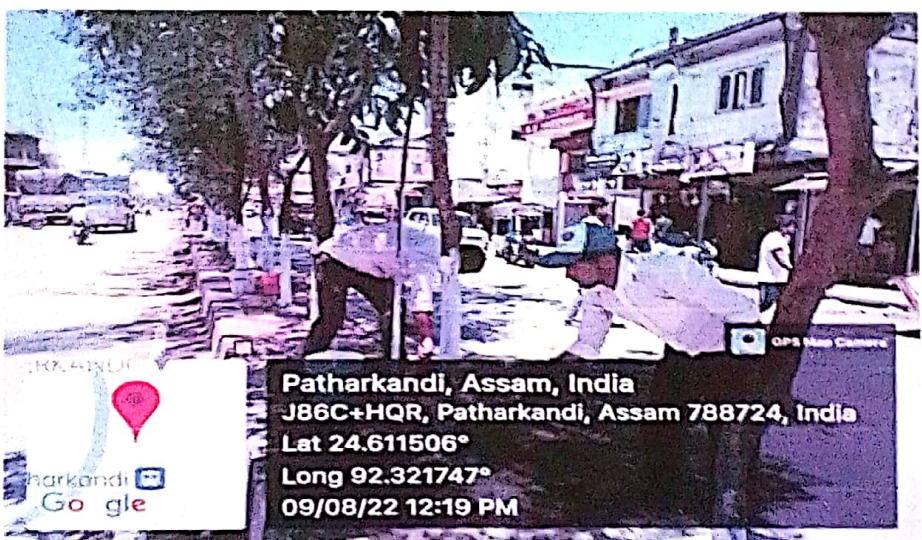

Red Ribbon Club, Patharkandi College Unit

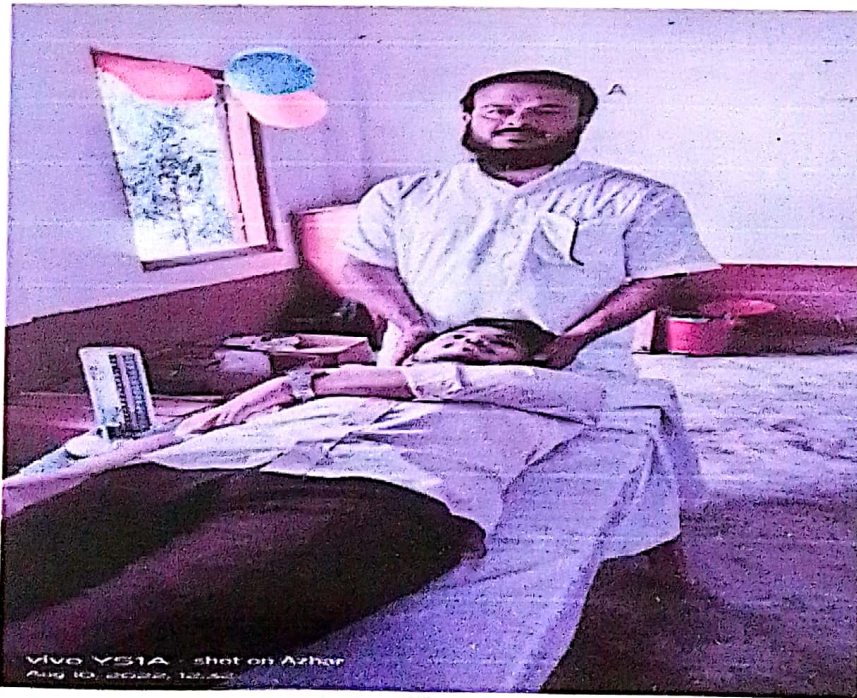


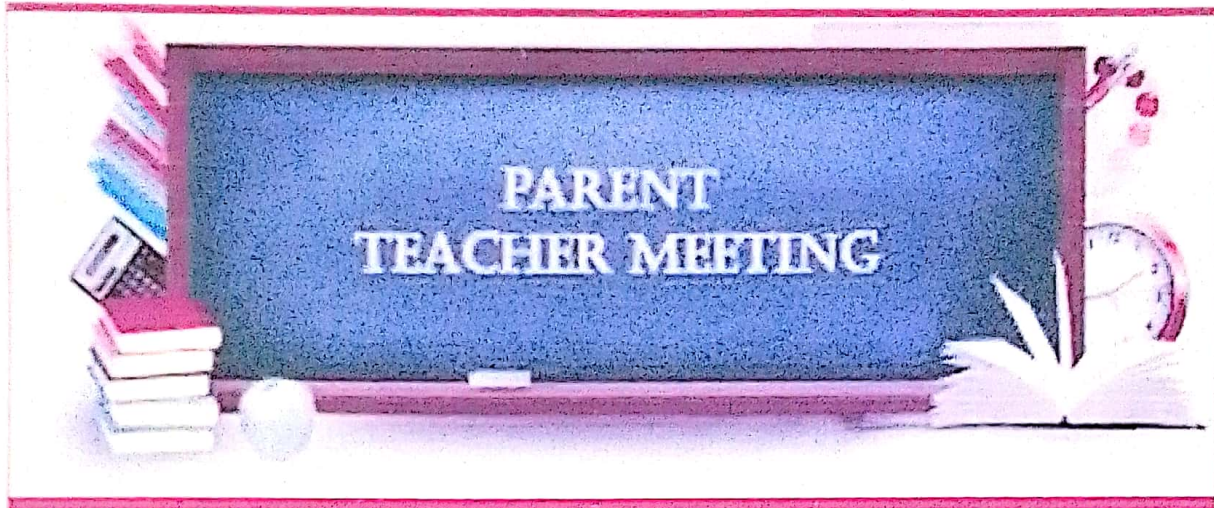
Silchar Medical College Blood Bank

Apart from donation, the camp also provided various other services like- blood group detection, health awareness etc.





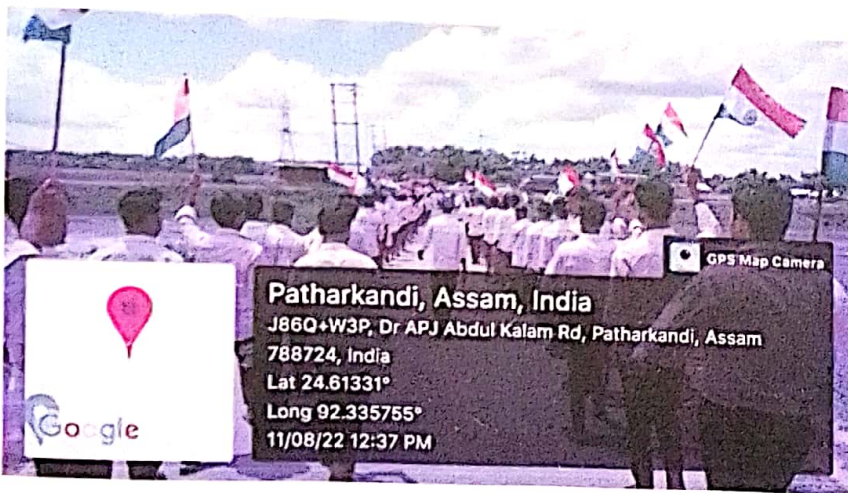
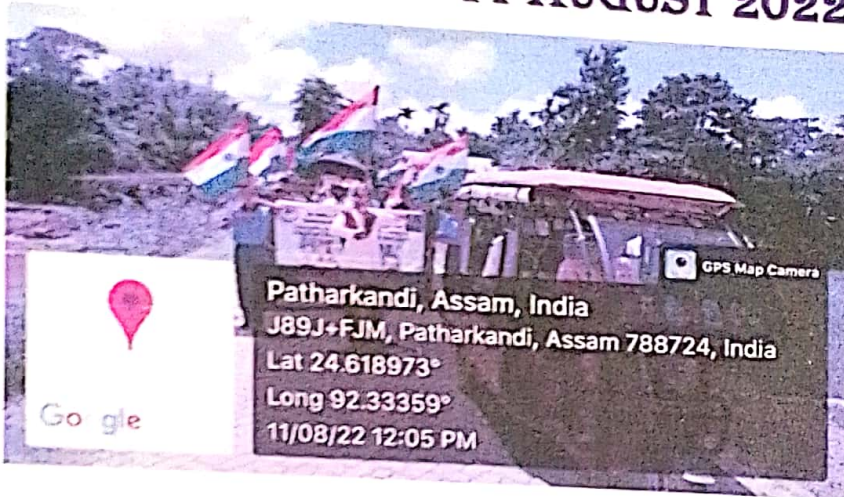
