### Aims and Objective

The main aim of observing this week by the College is to provide monetary support the noble cause of the organization.

The posters send by the Government of India were posted in the Notice board of the College and few donation box were prepared on which the posters were pasted. On 19<sup>th</sup> Nov, 2022, the students, teaching and non-teaching were made aware of the Organization and the main objective of the organization and importance of the observation of the Communal Harmony Campaign Week and Flag Day. The donation money was collected from 21<sup>st</sup> Nov, 2022 to 24<sup>th</sup> Nov, 2022 from the students, non-teaching and teaching staffs. The person who has donated for the noble cause was provided with a sticker as received from the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India. Nine thousand three hundred and sixty rupees (Rs. 9360) was donated by the students of the College. The teaching and non-teaching staffs of the College donated an amount of six thousand and four

hundred and eighty rupees only (Rs. 6480). A total of fifteen thousand eight hundred and forty rupees (Rs. 15,840) was donated from the College to the Organization.
