Aims and Objective

Prof., Dept. of Zoology, who have actively participated in the entire process of collection of money from the students, teaching and non-teaching staffs. On 19th Nov, 2022, the students, teaching and non-teaching were made aware of the Organization and the main objective of the organization and importance of the observation of the Communal Harmony Campaign Week and Flag Day. The donation money was collected from 21st Nov, 2022 to 24th Nov, 2022 from the students, non-teaching and teaching staffs. 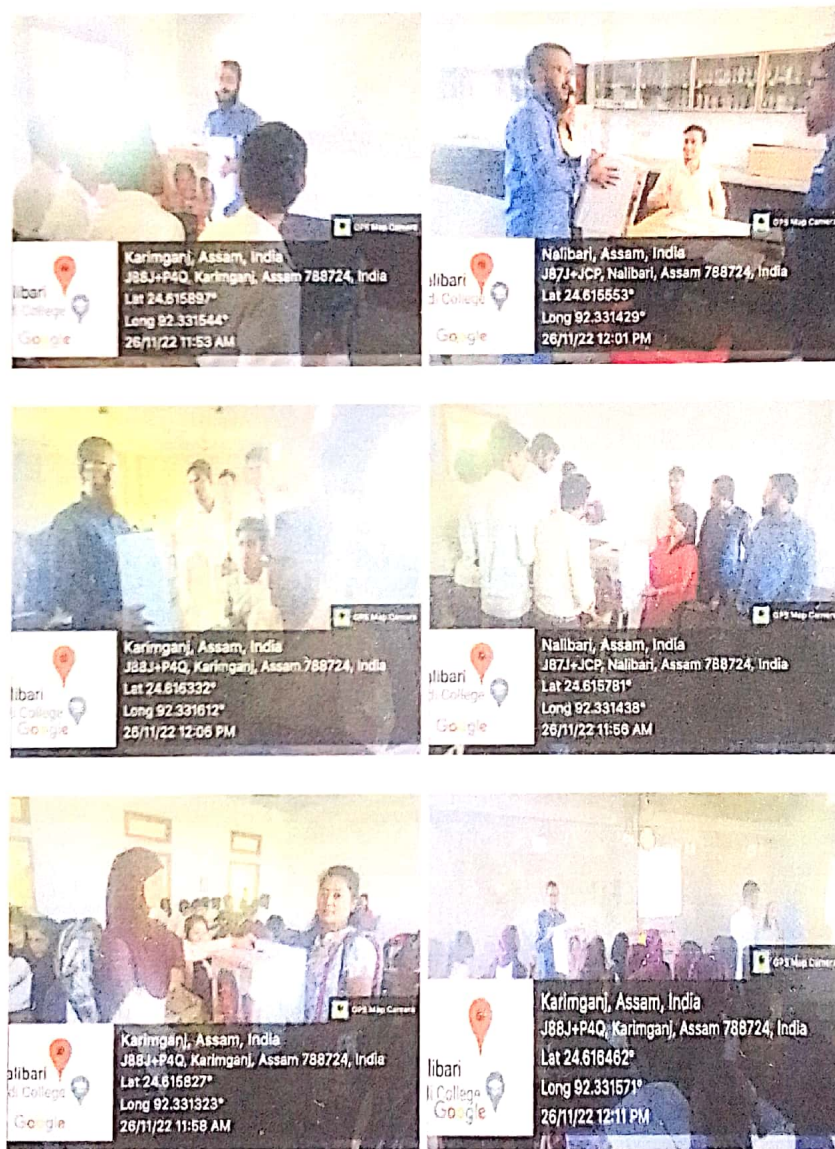


Figure: Photographs taken during the Collection from Students
