DISTRIBUTION OF GARMENTS TO THE NEEDY PEOPLE OF THE ADOPTED VILLAGE OF RAJBARI HELD ON 14 DEC 2019

The World Bank updated its data in the Poverty and Inequality Platform based on the adoption of a new global poverty line as of September 15, 2022. However, this update also includes data on India's poverty, which has been absent for ten years. This has an impact on global poverty levels as well as giving Indians awareness of their nation's poverty for the first time in ten years.

10 percent of Indians were poor in 2018, down from 22.5 percent in 2011, according to this update on Indian poverty using the revised \$2.15 per day poverty standard. 11.9 percent of the population lived in poverty in rural India, compared to 6.4 percent in urban regions.

We are aware that some of India's underprivileged citizens do not meet their basic demands. Even some of them have not fulfilled their basic two-meal requirement. So, they are unable to provide clothing for their family members to keep them warm during the winter. Keeping these things in mind, Patharkandi College N.S.S Unit managed 100 garments to distribute among the old age people especially female members of the locality. These people happily received it. The first item of clothing was distributed during the event's opening session by Mithilesh Chakraborty, assistant professor of department at Bengali Karbianglog College. The Principal, Dr. Monjurul Hoque, then the P.O. of the Patharkandi College Unit, Dr. Md. Imam Uddin Ansari, distributed cloths after that. The programme was finished within 2 hours.
