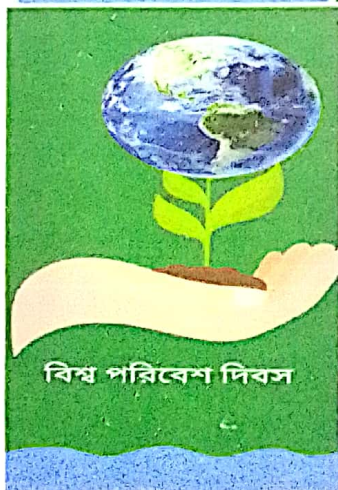
### ABOUT THE SEMINAR
